ACCOUNTABILITY

The incumbent is functionally accountable for all tasks related to the Industrial Sewage Treatment Plant requirements and reports directly to the Senior Environmental Coordinator.

- Calibrate all probes and inspect the process.
- Commence the start of the regeneration process on the zeolites.
- Intermittently monitor the regeneration process, and the quality of treated discharge.
- Ensure chemical feed tanks are topped up when required.
- Troubleshoot potential issues with the treatment system.
- Assist the environmental department with sampling and monitoring requirements.
- Assist Mill Supervisors in any Mill Operations or surface work required.
- Assist in the performance of regular and unscheduled maintenance and repairs on laboratory instruments, equipment and process machinery.
- Maintain excellent field notes that are accurate and thorough.
- Follow regulatory compliance.
- Maintains safe and clean working environment by complying with procedures, rules and regulations.
- Report safety concerns to management on site.
- Ability to work independently or with a group indoors and outdoors.
